

## AFLC General Fund

The General Fund of the AFLC is overseen by the Co-ordinating Committee and includes the Presidents Office and Business Office salaries and expenses. The General Fund provides services to other AFLC ministries from the Business office including bookkeeping/administrative services, building maintenance, insurance, office equipment, etc. The General Fund also covers the expenses for the Annual Conference, Co-ordinating Committee Board travel, and other miscellaneous board travel.

The General Fund can often be overlooked as a ministry to support since it's expenses are primarily administrative. However, the General Fund provides services to all AFLC ministries as well as covers the work of the President's Office, which includes but isn't limited to assisting with the church and pastoral roster, visiting churches, training lay pastors, etc. The General Fund goes underfunded year after year; and although it's not particularly glamorous to support, much of the AFLC's ministry would not take place without it. In 2024, the General Fund ended the year with a deficit of \$32,000. In 2023, the General Fund ended with a \$122,000 deficit.

Please be in prayer with the Co-ordinating Committee that God would inspire churches and individuals to come alongside in helping to reach and even exceed the budgeted goals of the General Fund. This will further the impact in building God's Kingdom.
