

## Mary and Martha House Bunk Beds

Mary and Martha House at The ARC still uses its original 1950s bunk beds – units that no longer meet current safety standards and are now showing signs of critical structural wear from decades of use. Replacing them is a necessary step toward ensuring guest safety and comfort.

This need is echoed across all of The ARC's lodging facilities, where each bunk bed has faithfully served for decades and is now ready for a well-deserved retirement.

New bunks will meet state and federal guidelines, offer a sturdier and more comfortable rest, and enhance the look and feel of the lodging rooms.

The full replacement project at Mary and Martha House will cost \$11,900.

Each bunk unit, like the one pictured to the right, costs \$1,100 plus shipping.
