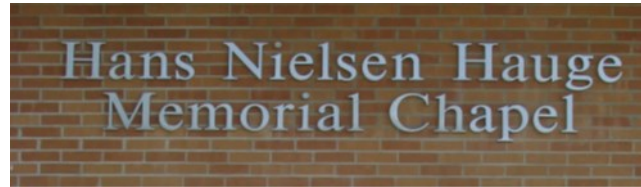

Free Lutheran Seminary Chapel Improvements



The Hans Nielsen Hauge Memorial Chapel building is the home to the Seminary and is the center of the AFLC campus. Chapel services are held for the student bodies of the Seminary and Bible College each Thursday morning. The Bible College uses the chapel for their own Tuesday chapel services as well. The chapel sanctuary is where concerts, graduations, recitals, weddings, funerals and other events are held.

Although the chancel of the Hauge Memorial Chapel has been remodeled to accommodate the donated pipe organ, the chapel flooring is original to the building and is showing its age. Many tiles are cracked, chipped or missing. The chapel was built in 1960 and the floor tile is in dire need of replacement.



Flooring:



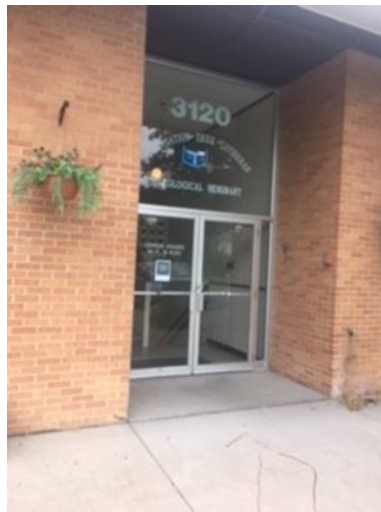
The area in greatest need of replacement is the upper chapel level which is approximately 5000 square feet. Preliminary estimates have come in at around \$33,000 to replace the chapel sanctuary flooring. This is assuming a cost of \$6 - \$7 per square foot to complete the project.

Security Doors:

The Chapel doors also need to be replaced with electronic security doors. West Entrance (\$18,000), the South Entrance (\$16,000) and North Entrance (\$18,000) all need to be replaced.
