## SYSTEMATIC THEOLOGY FACULTY POSITION

After careful consideration, the FLBCS Board of Trustees approved establishing a Permanent Endowment for the sole purpose of funding the faculty position of Systematic Theology.

As we look to the future, we have determined the Systematic Theology position is the most critical. This faculty position oversees the curriculum and the teaching of Systematic Theology. Having this position ensures to the Congregations that we will always have a focus on Systematic Theology at our Seminary. The Systematic Theology curriculum is designed to meet the high standards of God's Word and the FLBCS standards for this course. This is part of the core requirements for training the servant pastors before they are available for call.

**FLBCS Systematic Theology covers these major areas:**

- Basic Principles of Theology
- Doctrine of the Word
- Soteriology (Doctrine of Salvation)
- Ecclesiology and Eschatology (nature of the Church and last things)
- Christology and Pneumatology (Christ and The Holy Spirit)
- Theology and Anthropology (God and man)



This faculty member also must be familiar with and wholeheartedly supportive of incorporating AFLC principles of free and living congregations that is from our heritage and in line with God's Word a key to our future. They must have a good working understanding of the documents from the Georg Sverdrup Society. A focus will be given to see that these key principles are always woven into the curriculum.

This position is a regular full-time faculty position with limited other duties. This faculty member is under the direction and guidance of the Chief Academic Officer and Dean of the Seminary.

This position will be fully endowed when the fund reaches \$2.5M. Please pray about what God would lead you to do in funding this position.
