HISTORY OF THE AFCLC

In a combined effort by the Coordinating Committee and the Board of Trustees, Pastor Robert Lee has been commissioned to write a book about the history of the AFCLC.

Pastor Lee serves as Professor of Church History at the Seminary and Bible School, he has taught for 30 years. He has also served several AFCLC churches. He is the one person most qualified to write such a book because of his long history with the AFCLC and his love for church history. He is very gifted in remembering people, places, events and the connections that exist between them all. Besides being a professor, Pastor Lee has served several congregations in the AFCLC and was the President of the AFCLC for about 15 years.



The Board of Trustees has approved giving Pastor Lee a semester off from his part time teaching so that he can focus his time on writing this book.

The book will be of great value to all of us who have memories of the beginning of the AFCLC, but even more valuable to future generations in helping them understand foundations of the AFCLC and what led to its formation. Now is the time to write this history before it is lost.

In a visit with Pastor Lee he shared that he has much research to do in order to gather all the complete and accurate details. Pastor Lee stated that some of the contents would deal with topics or ideas such as a dream that would not die, polity, and theology



This book will be published by the Ambassador Publications as part of the AFLC Heritage Series. The books in this series are of theological historical, biographical or devotional content, with a goal to include new works, works previously published and works not previously translated. Ambassador Publications is providing research assistance to Pastor Lee and will work closely with him in the preparation of the book.

The AFLC Heritage series was established to help preserve the history and heritage of the AFLC and consists of writings that reflect the Lutheran, pietistic, and Scandinavian heritage of the AFLC.

The estimated cost to write this book will be about \$55,000.00 to cover the cost of a first printing and Pastor Lee's salary for the semester.
