PARISH BUILDING PROGRAM

The Parish Building Program has been an ongoing program that was derived from a need we saw in our church plants across the United States. We recognized that it was not enough for the pastor and pastor's wife to run the ministry and there often wasn't money for the church to hire on additional staff. This launched the idea of the Parish Builder; someone to come alongside this developing congregation to use the gifts God has given them to further this ministry and the Kingdom of God – wherever there is a need.

We are currently seeking funds to provide annual retreats and training for our current Parish Builders as well as offer promotional events at the Association Free Lutheran Bible School [AFLBS] for students interested in the program.
