## HELP START A CHURCH: \$12,000 SEED GRANT

AFLC Home Missions is helping churches start churches. In the next year, we plan on helping three new congregations start – 30 new churches in 10 years.

You can help by **funding a \$12,000 matching grant**. The Home Missions Committee awards churches with a vision to plant new churches with a matching grant to get started. The \$12,000 becomes \$24,000 when a sponsoring congregation takes up the call to send in a planter, do the work of an evangelist, begin a gospel-centered outreach, and organize weekly Bible studies. **Five grants will be awarded each year**, but sponsors of this can raise the number to **six or seven matching grants**. These grants will fund the **first year of outreach** and give churches with a call to plant a head start.
