HELP A NEW CHURCH GET ESTABLISHED: \$60,000 SOWER GRANT

Jesus said in his parable, “A sower went out to sow,” says Mark 4:4-8. “And as he sowed, some seed fell along the path... other seed fell on rocky ground... other seed fell among thorns... and other seeds fell into good soil and produced grain, growing up and increasing and yielding thirtyfold and sixtyfold and a hundredfold.” We believe it’s time to see the Gospel fall on good soil in the US. We are praying and planning for 30 new AFLC churches in the next 10 years.

Our current budget allows for two **sower grants** of \$60,000 to help new starts get off the ground. You can help by **funding a third church**.

The mission of AFLC Home Missions is to **help** churches start churches. Instead of doing the work from headquarters, **we believe congregations can do the work better and faster**. We believe the best way to reach the most people for Christ in the most efficient way is to help **gospel-centered churches** plant new congregations.

- The **SOWER GRANT** doubles our investment. The grant to new churches becomes **\$120,000** in three years.
- Home Missions awards matching grants to AFLC congregations with a vision to plant new churches. We hope to give **3 grants/year** (\$20,000 + \$20,000 + \$20,000).
- **Matching grants** are dispersed over three years and support **pastors, families, and gospel outreach events.**
