

In order to better serve our congregations, the scope of our ministry has broadened to include an increased number of curriculum projects as well as other needed resources. This requires more personnel than we presently have available.





student book completed.*





***What would it cost?***

Adding an administrative assistant would cost approximately \$55,000 per year. We are looking to fund this new position for three years by your gracious and loving help, until we can build the position into the budget. The opportunity that we have before us is to raise the funds for those three years, giving us time to increase the budget to maintain this new position. The total estimated cost for the three years is \$165,000.
