## Miriam Home Family Sponsorship

Around the world children need safe and nurturing environments. God's plan is for this to take place in the family setting at home. Unfortunately this does not always happen for various reasons. Sometimes the family situation deteriorates to the point that the children are not even safe in the home. When that happens action needs to be taken.

Where we minister in Brazil we provide a home to help children in these situations. Normally the children are placed in the home by a judge looking out for their welfare. The children come quickly, sometimes even unannounced. We give them a stable loving environment, where they are safe and learn about the Savior. Our greatest desire is that these children would have a permanent home in eternity with the Heavenly Father.

The goal of the judge and social workers is to place the children in a safe home environment as soon as possible. Sometimes they can go back to their mother and father. Often they are placed in a different home. Many times it is hard to find a loving family that can afford to take these children. There are people who express a desire to sponsor children while they are in the home, but this is



We know that these children need a connection with the Savior and church after they leave the home. Sponsoring a family will help the children find a good home and foster a connection with the Lord.

There are plans to sponsor families, through the local congregation. The sponsorship will continue the spiritual influence in the child's life. Families that would like to take in children, but can't afford to, would receive some financial support through the congregation and the church could use this as an outreach tool.
