### Helping Children at the Miriam Home

Around the world children need safe and nurturing environments. God's plan is for this to take place in the family setting at home. Unfortunately this does not always happen for various reasons. Sometimes the family situation deteriorates to the point that the children are not even safe in their home. When that happens action needs to be taken.

Where we minister in Brazil we provide a home to help children in these situations.

Normally the children are placed in the home by a judge looking out for their welfare. The children come quickly, sometimes even unannounced. We give them a stable loving environment, where they are safe and learn about the Savior. Our greatest desire is that these children would have a permanent home in eternity with the Heavenly Father.

The goal of the judge and social workers is to place the children in a safe home environment as soon as possible. We receive many requests from people who would like to have a child from the home to sponsor. Because the children are always in transition, it is hard to know which children will be in the home from week to week. Therefore, it is impossible to assign specific children to individuals for support. AFLC World Missions feels it is important to have a safe, stable and consistent environment for these children whose life is in turmoil. Providing consistent professional staff and leadership at the Home helps in numerous ways .





Silvio Paes a professional businessman from the community has accepted a call to oversee the Miriam Home. This is a great sacrifice for Silvio as it means a large reduction in salary, but it is worth it for the children. Each child will be blessed by his leadership.
